Joy of Sharing Holiday Program:

United Way of West Central Connecticut's Annual Joy of Sharing Program has been providing food, toys, and gifts to needy children, teens, and families in Bristol, Burlington, Plainville, Plymouth and Terryville for over 12 years. 
RESULTS
